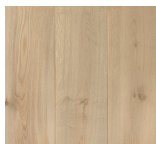

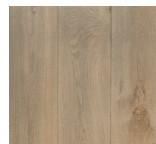

Patched knots and cracks will be present and are finished with filler dependent on the products colour.
